<p>Individual Student Quarantine (student/s w/in a class are quarantined, however the class has not been quarantined nor has the teacher)</p> <p>Quarantined student/s will check-out their individually assigned Chromebook</p>	<p>Quarantined students will have access to the teacher's Canvas site to stay current on in-class work.</p> <p>Some learning activities may be made-up upon the student's return.</p>	<p>Teachers will continue to use Canvas.</p> <p>Teachers will check-in with quarantined students weekly.</p> <p>If a student does not have access to the internet outside of school, parents can request a Hot Spot from the school.</p>	<p>Attendance will be determined by evidence of learning through Canvas, submission of work via email, completion of work upon return from quarantine, or any combination thereof.</p>
<p>Teacher Quarantine (teacher has been quarantined, but the class has not)</p>	<p>A substitute staff member will fill-in for the regular classroom teacher.</p>	<p>Same as they would for regular in-person instruction.</p>	<p>Same as it would for regular in person instruction.</p>
<p>Teacher/Student Quarantine (teacher has been quarantined and some students in the class have also been quarantined)</p> <p>Quarantined student/s will check-out their individually assigned Chromebook</p>	<p>A substitute staff member will fill-in for the regular classroom teacher for students not quarantined.</p> <p>Quarantined students, depending on the amount, will engage in learning in one of the following ways. They may be assigned to another teacher's classroom, a substitute staff member may be assigned, or the quarantined teacher will teach through Canvas to the quarantined students (see classroom quarantine plan).</p>	<p>In-person students will receive support as they would for regular in-person instruction.</p> <p>Quarantined students will receive support through continued use of Canvas and weekly teacher check-ins.</p> <p>If a student does not have access to the internet outside of school, parents can request a Hot Spot from the school, subject to availability.</p>	<p>In-person student attendance will be the same as it is for regular in person instruction.</p> <p>Quarantined student attendance will be determined by evidence of learning through Canvas, submission of work via email, completion of work upon return from quarantine, or any combination thereof.</p>
<p>Classroom Quarantine (All students in the class have been quarantined as well as the teacher)</p> <p>Quarantined students will check-out their individually assigned Chromebook</p>	<p>Students login and participate in class through Canvas.</p> <p>Access to Canvas for independent learning.</p>	<p>Students will follow their class schedule with their teacher/s and classmates.</p> <p>If a student does not have access to the internet outside of school, parents can request a Hot Spot from the school, subject to availability.</p>	<p>Attendance will be determined by synchronous attendance during the live Canvas sessions and/or evidence of learning through Canvas, submission of work via email, completion of work upon return from quarantine, or any combination thereof.</p>
<p>School Quarantine (the entire school is quarantined)</p> <p>Quarantined students will check-out their individually assigned Chromebook</p>	<p>All staff and students implement temporary remote learning using Canvas within normal school hours.</p>	<p>Students will follow their remote class schedule with their teacher/s & classmates.</p> <p>If a student does not have access to the internet outside of school, parents can request a Hot Spot from the school, subject to availability.</p>	<p>Attendance will be determined by synchronous attendance during the live Canvas sessions and/or evidence of learning through Canvas, submission of work via email, completion of work upon return from quarantine, or any combination thereof.</p>
